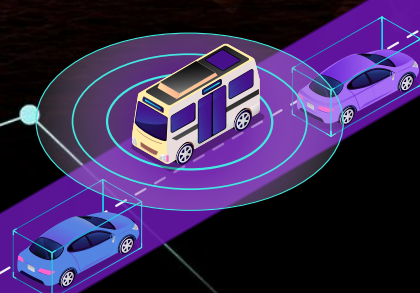
Mr Gary LEUNG

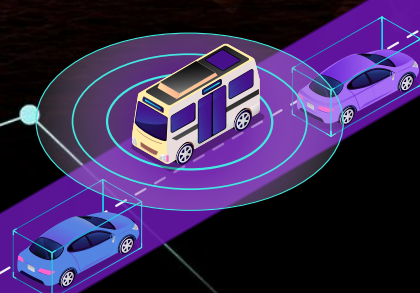
Ms Irene LAU

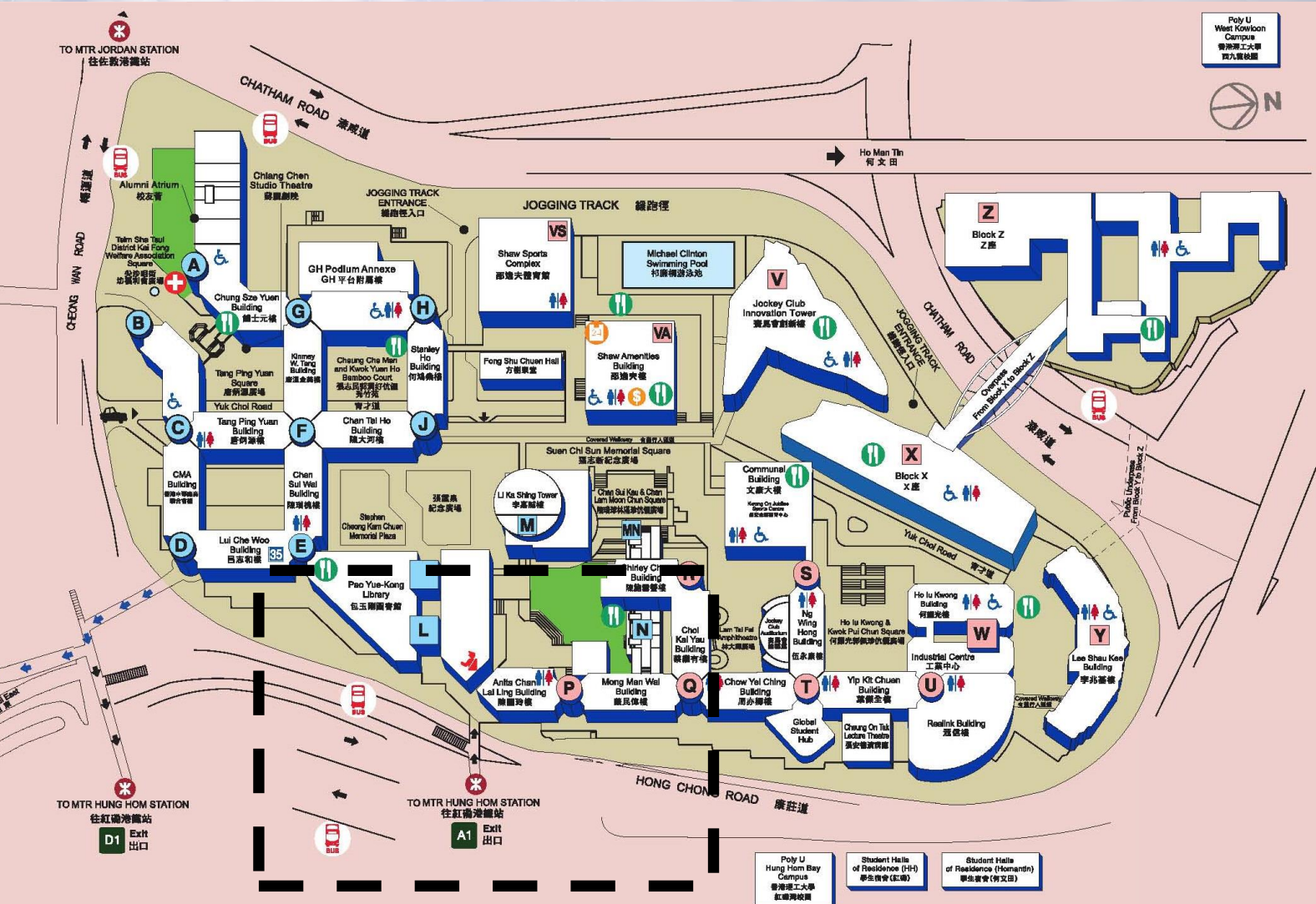
