Women-Friendly Public Transport Survey Report 2025

An academic research on worldwide women-friendly public transport policies was published and presented during the WiLAT Global Workshop on 14 September 2025. Led by Professor Anthony Yeh and Dr. Si Qiao from the University of Hong Kong, WiLAT Global and WiLAT Hong Kong were proud to have co-developed and supported the survey through its development.



The survey findings highlight:

- Safety concerns for women in public transport, and
- Recommendations involving safety measures and smart/mobile app enhancements to improve security.

WiLAT co-hosted the “Rewiring Gateway-to-Door Operations Forum” with Hang Seng Carbon Academy at Hang Seng Bank Tower on 8 October 2025. This landmark event marked the first collaboration between WiLAT Hong Kong and a financial institution, offering a unique perspective on ESG from the financial sector’s viewpoint.

Over 150 professionals from the government and logistics industry attended to understand how sustainability principles

can be integrated into logistics and transport operations, emphasizing the role of financial strategies in accelerating ESG adoption, in the future of logistics in Hong Kong – from smarter warehousing and greener last-mile delivery, to integrating energy data and improving energy use in logistics centres.
